## HOT COCOA RECIPE

Creamy, rich, and decadent slow cooker hot chocolate made in the crockpot!

### Ingredients

- 6 cups (1440ml) whole milk
- 2 cups (480ml) heavy cream
- 1/2 cup (100g) granulated sugar
- 8 ounces (226g) semi-sweet chocolate, coarsely chopped
- 1/4 cup (21g) unsweetened natural or dutch-process cocoa powder
- 2 teaspoons pure vanilla extract

### Instructions

Place all of the ingredients into a large slow cooker. Vigorously whisk to get the cocoa powder as mixed in as possible- you don't want it all floating on the top. Keep whisking for a minute or 2 until it's all combined.

Cook on low for 6 hours or on high for 4 hours. Make sure you whisk it every 45 minutes - 1 hour to make sure the chocolate isn't burning on the bottom.

## Ash Tree Removal in Wildwood Last Month plus EAB Update

City Forestry contractors removed ash trees near sidewalks or roads that were considered a public safety hazard. They were either dead, in decline or structurally unsound. Most, if not all had a purple dot painted on them.

Good news; the Emerald Ash Borer (EAB) that are deadly to ash trees are still restricted to the Archibald area of St. Boniface.

Our Wildwood forest is in decline; the elms and oaks are dying.

### Take care of the trees you have;

- water them every two weeks in dry times
- get them professionally pruned
- avoid compacting or covering over their roots.

### Plant trees.

Come to the community planting events.

Help save our forest and our planet.

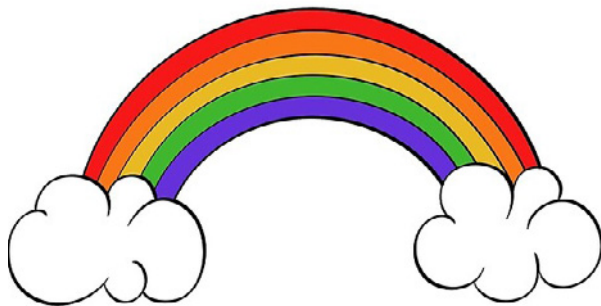
